#### National Membership Database Manager's Report for National Executive Meeting 9th March 2023

#### **Membership Database Activities Since 2022 FCM**

Membership Database Management activity since the FCM has been routine with membership updates following advice from Div Secretaries or Treasurers of member subs payment, processing new memberships (only 9), cancelling those that chose to resign or not renew (5 to date), and sadly recording a growing list of members who have 'Crossed the Bar' (15 + 4 previous members).

In addition to the December softcopy Slipstream promulgation advice emails, I have also processed a bulk email mailing advising of the 2023 NSW Div AGM.

Changes from the latest Australia Post sort codes for the period 24<sup>th</sup> Feb 2023 to 24<sup>th</sup> Aug 2023 have been incorporated into the database (minimal changes this time around).

#### **Membership Statistics**

Our current membership stands at 768 members, unfortunately another drop from 767 as at the FCM.

Since the FCM we have gained 9 new members, as follows:

- a. 3 for NSW Div, 2 Associates and 1 previous member
- b. 2 for VIC Div, 1 a previous member
- c. 2 for QLD Div; and
- d. 2 for WA Div.

Offsetting the 9 new members, we lost 20 members; 5 resignations and 15 members who sadly "Crossed the Bar", and we currently have 1 membership application pending.

However, of the 768 members mentioned above, only 582 are recorded as being financial for 2023 based on current advice received from Divisions, with 186 still to renew, as detailed below:
